The End of Analysis. Freud. Lacan.

**Description:**

This seminar will look at the end of analysis for these two main figures of psychoanalysis. We will examine the differences in light of the formation of the analyst, the ethics of the practice and the effect of one and the other end, in the analyst's own clinical work.

We will be reading both Freud and Lacan and will come to see how post Freudians, particularly in the IPA, have looked at the matter, as well as the post Lacanians.

**Objectives:**

- Describe examples of clinical questions of the end of the analysis.
- Analyze differences of Freudian and Lacanian techniques about the ethics of psychoanalysis.
- Discuss why a personal analysis for a psychoanalyst is crucial to function and to be able to conduct a treatment to its end.

**Bio:**

Gabriela Zorzutti finished her Doctorate in Psychology at the University of Buenos Aires, and her Masters in Clinical Psychology at the Universidad Nacional de Mar del Plata. Dr. Zorzutti lives and practices psychoanalysis in Denver and Washington DC ever since she moved from her home country of Argentina to live here 18 years ago. During those years, she has founded the Colorado Analytic Forum of the Lacanian Field (2010) and its Clinical College of Colorado (2014) as well as the Lacanian Clinic (2015).
