Psychoanalysis with Diversity in Mind: *The Fire Next Time*, by James Baldwin

Facilitated by Margy Stewart, Psy.D. & Jennifer Perlman, Psy.D.

Course Description:

This class will focus on the reading James Baldwin's landmark book, *The Fire Next Time*. Discussion of Baldwin's ideas and discussion of our reaction and ideas about race and racism will be divided over 3 sessions. We hope participants will engage in looking inward at reactions to race and racism to develop increased comfort with addressing experience of race in clinical work with patients and to look at the therapist's or analyst's transference and countertransference reactions regarding race and racism. We will discuss trauma and race.

Objectives:

1. Describe internal reactions including transference and countertransference influenced by race
2. Discuss racism and traumatization

Bios:

Jennifer Perlman, Psy.D. is a licensed psychologist in Denver. She has worked with homeless services for over 15 years using a diversity and trauma lens to understand the complex issues of homelessness. She is currently in private practice working to help people understand themselves deeply so that they may continue to meet life with authenticity, courage and wholeheartedly.

Margy Stewart, Psy.D. is a psychologist/psychoanalyst in Denver. She has extensive experience working with patients with relational trauma, suffering and oppression. Part of her focus as President of the Denver Psychoanalytic Society is broadening awareness of diversity within psychoanalysis.
