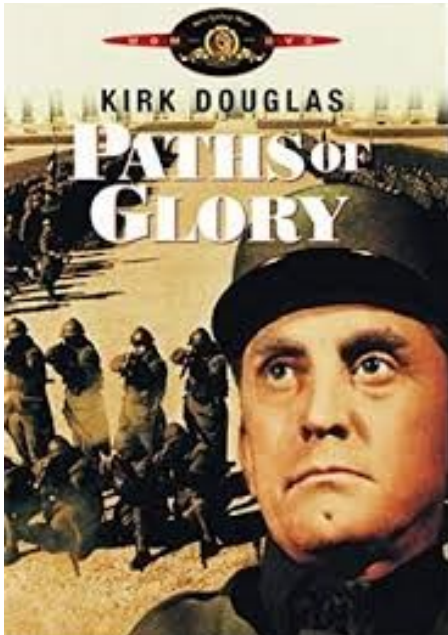


# THE DENVER PSYCHOANALYTIC SOCIETY'S FILM SERIES



“Paths of Glory” is Stanley Kubrick’s 1957 masterpiece on the random terror and insanity of war. The film is based on an actual incident that occurred in the French Army during the First World War—an event so shocking and senseless as to be almost unbelievable. Kirk Douglas gives the most restrained and deeply moving performance of his long career, and the

film itself has grown more profound with every passing year and with every passing war.

## OBJECTIVES:

1. Explain the psychological impact of war and deepen awareness that need for treatment may emerge years after the trauma.
2. Apply empathy and understanding when working with soldiers and veterans.
3. Explain how treating soldiers and veterans may be different than treating other patients as it relates to war, specifically PTSD, cowardly conduct, shell shock trauma and economic and family problems.
